NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 18-90

**GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY**  
**BAYOU BOEUF LOCK - SPECIAL ADVISORY (UPDATE)**

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 18-39, dated 5 March 2018, stating that Bayou Boeuf Lock is closed for navigation passage until further notice, and will remain closed as long as the head differential remains above 1.5 feet due to high river conditions.


**THE REPAIRS OF THE EAST END GATES ARE COMPLETED. BAYOU BOEUF LOCK WILL BE REOPENED TO TRAFFIC ON 8 JULY 2018. THE WEST END GATES WILL BE REMOVED FOR REPAIRS STARTING 13 JULY 2018. THE TENTATIVE LOCK CLOSURES ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

- 8 THRU 13 JULY 2018 - THE LOCK WILL BE OPEN TO TRAFFIC IN OPEN-PASS OPERATION.
- 14 THRU 18 JULY 2018 - THE LOCK WILL BE CLOSED DURING DAYTIME HOURS FROM 7:00 AM TO 7:00 PM, AND OPEN TO TRAFFIC DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS FROM 7:00 PM TO 7:00 AM.
- 19 JULY 2018 - THE LOCK WILL BE OPEN TO TRAFFIC IN OPEN-PASS OPERATION UNTIL THE RIVER CONDITIONS CHANGE.

**THE BYPASS ROUTE AROUND BAYOU BOEUF LOCK USING BAYOU CHENE IS AVAILABLE FOR PASSAGE.**
