NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 18-138

HOUMA NAVIGATION CANAL
TERREBONNE BAY AND CAT ISLAND PASS

Commencing on or about 12 October 2018 and continuing until approximately 1 January 2019, the U.S. Government Contract Cutterhead Dredge ROBERT M. WHITE will be working in the Houma Navigation Canal from approximately mile -3.35 to mile 10.75.

The dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Concerning the work in Terrebonne Bay, the dredge will deposit dredged material into open water, through a floating pipeline, 2000 feet west of the Houma Navigation Canal channel centerline.

Concerning the work in Cat Island Pass, the dredge will deposit dredged material into point discharge placement sites, through a floating pipeline, approximately 1500 feet west of the channel centerline.

Besides dredging equipment, there are numerous work and support vessels associated with this dredging operation. The dredge can be contacted on either VHF channel 13 or 16 for sailing instructions.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
