NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 17-61

MISSISSIPPI RIVER
VICINITY OF SOUTHWEST PASS (UPDATE)

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 17-18, dated 16 March 2017, stating that the U.S. Government Contract Cutterhead Dredge CAPT. FRANK will be working in Southwest Pass from Head of Passes (mile 0) to the lower jetty and bar channel, and the Mississippi River from Head of Passes to mile 11 Above Head of Passes (AHP) until approximately 31 July 2017.


MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE DREDGING OPERATIONS HAVE BEEN EXTENDED UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 23 AUGUST 2017.

The dredged material will be deposited through a combination of floating and submerged pipelines into designated placement areas.

The Dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and can be contacted on either VHF channel 67 or 16 for sailing instructions.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
