NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 18-127

MISSISSIPPI RIVER
SOUTHWEST PASS
JETTY AND FORESHORE DIKE REPAIRS

Beginning on or about 17 September 2018 and continuing until approximately 31 August 2019, a U.S. Government Contractor will be repairing the jetty and foreshore dikes on the Right Descending Bank (RDB) and Left Descending Bank (LDB) of Southwest Pass from Head of Passes (mile 0) to -20.0 Below Head of Passes (BHP).

The Contractor will work 7 days a week, during daylight hours. The operations will include several sites working concurrently with multiple spud barges and tugboats on-site and staged outside the channel.

The M/V CROSBY RAMBLER and M/V JULIE MARIE will monitor VHF-FM marine channels 16 and 72.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
