NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 17-52

MISSISSIPPI RIVER
DEEP DRAFT CROSSINGS

Commencing on or about 12 July 2017 and continuing until further notice, the U.S. Government Dustpan Dredge HURLEY will be working at the Mississippi River Deep Draft Crossings between mile 234 and mile 151 Above Head of Passes (AHP).

The first dredging location will be at Sardine Point Crossing, at approximate mile 219.3 AHP of the Mississippi River.

The Dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and will give way to vessels using the waterway. The Dredge can be contacted on either VHF channel 16 or 67 for sailing instructions.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
