NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 18-128

MISSISSIPPI RIVER
DEEP DRAFT CROSSINGS (UPDATE)

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 18-106, dated 10 August 2018, stating that the U.S. Government Contract Dustpan Dredge WALLACE McGEORGE will be working at the Mississippi River Deep Draft Crossings between mile 234 and mile 151 Above Head of Passes (AHP) until further notice.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE DREDGING OPERATIONS AT THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER CROSSINGS WILL BE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED ON APPROXIMATELY 19 SEPTEMBER 2018.

THE DREDGE WALLACE McGEORGE WILL THEN MOVE TO PERFORM DREDGING OPERATIONS AT THE FOREBAY OF PORT ALLEN LOCK THROUGH APPROXIMATELY 24 SEPTEMBER 2018. THE DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE DEPOSITED THROUGH A FLOATING PIPELINE INTO DEEP WATER OF THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER. NAVIGATION SHOULD EXPECT SOME INTERMITTENT DELAYS WITH LOCKING THROUGH THE STRUCTURE DUE TO THE DREDGING OPERATIONS.

ON APPROXIMATELY 24 SEPTEMBER 2018, THE DREDGE WILL THEN RESUME WORKING AT THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER DEEP DRAFT CROSSINGS BETWEEN MILE 234 AND MILE 151 ABOVE HEAD OF PASSES (AHP) UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 7 NOVEMBER 2018. THE DREDGE WILL WORK 24 HOURS A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK, AND WILL GIVE WAY TO VESSELS USING THE WATERWAY. THE DREDGE CAN BE CONTACTED ON EITHER VHF CHANNEL 16 OR 67 FOR SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
