c. Are regularly scheduled safety meetings being held (at least once a month) for supervisors? (01.B.05 (a))				
d. Is adequate communications and/or transportation available in the event of serious injury to personnel? (03.A.01(a) (b) (c))				
e. Are there two qualified first-aid and CPR attendant per shift on duty? (03.A.02(a))				
f. Are fire, man-overboard & abandon-ship drills (as applicable) conducted at least monthly? (19.A.03(g)(1)(2)) Note: These drills should first be conducted on the very first night shift.

a. Are haul roads properly marked for night work? (07.A.01 and 07.A.03)				
b. Is adequate lighting available in work areas, on decks and walkways? (07.A01, Table 7-1)				
c. Is adequate lighting available at crew boat loading area on floating plant? (16.I.06, 07.A.01 and 07.A.04)				
d. Are all vehicles, construction equipment properly lighted? (18.A.05 and 16.A.08(g))				
3 Transportation to and from floating plant				
a. Are boats equipped with sufficient number of life preservers? (19.A.03(d), 5.J.01(a) (b) (c) (d) (e) and 05.J.02)				
b. Are all vehicles and construction equipment properly lighted for night work? (18.J.04, 18.I.04, 18.H.10, 18.G.27(c), 18.G.15, 18.G.09, 18.C.15, 18.C.06 and 18.A.059(a)(b)(c)(d))				
c. If boat is less than 20 feet in length, has it been tested for flotation and stability, or does it carry 33 CFR 183 certification? (19.F.02(c))				
d. If more than 6 passengers are carried, or boat is greater than 26 feet in length, is vessel Coast Guard certified and is the operator licensed? (19.A.02)				
e. For boats of less than 26 feet in length, is operator experienced, and his name posted as a designated small boat operator? (19.F.05(a) (b) (c)(d))				
f. Is weather deck of boat coated with non-skid material? (19.B.01(b))				
g. Is there safe, easy access from boat to landing? (19.B.02)				
h. Do guardrails meet requirements of (19.E.)?
