Interested parties are hereby notified that a permit application has been received by the New Orleans District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers pursuant to: [] Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of March 3, 1899 (30 Stat. 1151; 33 USC 403); and/or [X] Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (86 Stat. 816; 33 USC 1344).

Application has also been made to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services, for a Water Quality Certification (WQC) in accordance with statutory authority contained in LRS30:2074 A(3), and provisions of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P.L.95-17).

INSTALLATION OF A 20-INCH BRINE PIPELINE, CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW COMMERCIAL INDUSTRIAL FACILITY AND EXPANSION OF EXISTING FACILITY IN IBERVILLE PARISH

NAME OF APPLICANT: Shintech Louisiana, LLC, c/o Providence Engineering, Attn: Paul Clifton, 1201 Main Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70802.

LOCATION OF WORK: Located on an approximate 817.42-acre site, located approximately 3.9 miles southeast of Plaquemine, Louisiana, located in Iberville Parish, as shown on the enclosed drawings (Latitude 30.238053 N Longitude -91.1602297 W). This project is located in the Terrebonne Basin (Lower Grand HUC 08070300).

CHARACTER OF WORK: The applicant is requesting a Department of the Army permit authorization for the construction of the new Shintech Plaquemine Plant-3 (SPP-3) and expansion/modification of the existing Shintech Plaquemine Plant-1 (SPP-1). Both facilities would be integrated into the Shintech Plaquemine Plant Complex on the west bank of the Mississippi River, near Plaquemine, Iberville Parish, Louisiana. SPP-3 is a proposed manufacturing facility that would produce vinyl chloride monomer (VCM) and other intermediate products such as chlorine (caustic soda as a byproduct of chlorine production) and ethylene dichloride. Purified VCM is then sent to SPP-1 or shipped to produce polyvinyl chloride (PVC). SPP-3 also would contain a hydrochloric acid production unit. The proposed modification of SPP-1 would allow for the expansion of the PVC facility production. With this project's implementation, the PVC production would increase from 1,400 million pounds per year to 2,215 million pounds per year. This project also proposes the installation and maintenance of an approximate 11.5-mile long 20-inch diameter brine pipeline extending from the existing White Castle Oil and Gas facility to the Shintech Plaquemine Plant Complex. Approximately 76,581

cubic yards of native material would be placed in jurisdictional areas during the brine pipeline installation. Approximately 466,065 cubic yards of hauled in gravel/ballast material and 470,510 cubic yards of hauled in native soil fill material would be placed onsite in jurisdictional areas during the facility construction phase of this project. Approximately 34.9 acres of potentially jurisdictional herbaceous wetlands and 1.82 acres of potentially jurisdictional Other Waters of the United States (OWOUS) would be temporarily impacted as a result of the brine pipeline installation. Approximately 6.72 acres of potentially jurisdictional forested wetlands and 0.93 acre of potentially jurisdictional scrub-shrub wetlands would be permanently converted to herbaceous wetlands during the pipeline installation process. Approximately 6.52 acres of jurisdictional herbaceous wetlands, 10.47 acres of forested wetlands, and 0.22 acre of OWOUS would be permanently impacted via fill placement during the facility construction and expansion portions of this project. The applicant has claimed that the project has been designed to avoid and minimize direct and secondary adverse wetland impacts to the maximum extent practicable. The applicant is proposing to utilize best management practices during and after the construction phase of the project. A jurisdictional determination for the brine pipeline project area is currently pending in the Corps' Surveillance and Enforcement Section. If additional jurisdictional impacts are determined as a result of this determination, an addendum to this Public Notice shall be required. The applicant is proposing to compensate for the unavoidable impact by purchasing mitigation credits from an approved mitigation bank.

The comment period for the Department of Army Permit and the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality will close in **20 days** from the date of this joint public notice. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work, stating reasons thereof, are being solicited from anyone having interest in this permit and/or this WQC request and must be mailed so as to be received before or by the last day of the comment period. Letters concerning the Corps of Engineers permit application must reference the applicant's name and the Permit Application Number, and be mailed to the Corps of Engineers at the address above, ATTENTION: REGULATORY BRANCH. Similar letters concerning the Water Quality Certification must reference the applicant's name and the WQC application number and be mailed to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality at the address above. Individuals or parties may request an extension of time in which to comment on the proposed work by writing or e-mailing the Corps of Engineers Project Manager listed above. Any request must be specific and substantively supportive of the requested extension, and received by this office prior to the end of the initial comment period. The Section Chief will review the request and the requestor will be promptly notified of the decision to grant or deny the request. If granted, the time extension will be continuous to the initial comment period and, inclusive of the initial comment period, will not exceed a total of 30 calendar days.

The application for this proposed project is on file with the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality and may be examined during weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Copies may be obtained upon payment of costs of reproduction.

Corps of Engineers Permit Criteria

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts, including cumulative impacts of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit which reasonably may be expected to accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, historic properties, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, floodplain values, land use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs, safety, food and fiber production, mineral needs, considerations of property ownership and, in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

The US Army Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, federal, state, and local agencies and officials, Indian Tribes, and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the US Army Corps of Engineers to determine whether to make, modify, condition, or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects, and other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.

The New Orleans District is unaware of properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places near the proposed work. The possibility exists that the proposed work may damage or destroy presently unknown archeological, scientific, prehistorical, historical sites, or data. Copies of this notice are being sent to the State Archeologist and State Historic Preservation Officer.

Our initial finding is that the proposed work would neither affect any species listed as endangered by the U.S. Departments of Interior or Commerce, nor affect any habitat designated as critical to the survival and recovery of any endangered species. Utilizing Standard Local Operating Procedure for Endangered Species in Louisiana (SLOPES), dated October 22, 2014, between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New Orleans and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Ecological Services Office, the Corps has determined that the proposed activity would have no effect on any listed species.


This notice initiates the Essential Fish Habitat (EFH) consultation requirements of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act. The applicant's proposal would result in the destruction or alteration of $\underline{0}$ acres of EFH utilized by various life stages of red drum and penaeid shrimp. Our initial determination is that the proposed action would not have a substantial adverse impact on EFH or federally managed fisheries in the Gulf of Mexico. Our final determination relative to project impacts and the need for mitigation measures is subject to review by and coordination with the National Marine Fisheries Service.


If the proposed work involves deposits of dredged or fill material into navigable waters, the evaluation of the probable impacts will include the application of guidelines established by the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency. Also, a certification that the proposed activity will not violate applicable water quality standards will be required from the Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services, before a permit is issued.



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



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



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
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PERMIT APPLICATION FOR PROPOSED 20" x 63,798' PIPELINE

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
PERMIT APPLICATION FOR PROPOSED 20" x 63,798' PIPELINE

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

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

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
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
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
PIPELINE GENERAL LAYOUT MAP 5 OF 17







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












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PIPELINE
