Subject: Time extension to the comment period for the Helis Oil & Gas Company, LLC, proposal to clear, grade, excavate, and fill to construct a 10.55 acre drilling well pad to be used for subsurface hydraulic fracturing for the exploration and potential future extraction of oil and gas. Original public notice dated 15 April 2014.

LOCATION OF WORK: North of Interstate-12, east of LA Highway 1088, abutting the west side of Log Cabin Road, at Latitude: 30.38806, Longitude -89.97917, in St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

The comment period for the Department of the Army Permit and the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality WQC is hereby extended and **will now close 10 days** from the date of this joint public notice **on 15 May 2014**. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work, stating reasons thereof, are being solicited from anyone having interest in this permit and/or this WQC request and must be mailed so as to be received before or by the last day of the comment period. Letters concerning the Corps of Engineers permit application must reference the applicant's name and the Permit Application Number, and be mailed to the Corps of Engineers at the address above, **ATTENTION: REGULATORY BRANCH**. Similar letters concerning the Water Quality Certification must reference the applicant's name and the WQC Application number and be mailed to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality at the address above.

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application. Requests for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing.

You are requested to communicate the information contained in this notice to any other parties whom you deem likely to have interest in the matter.
