PERFORMANCE STATEMENT

BROWNLEE

TASK

Furnish labor, materials, equipment, and supervision to remove the crane barge BROWNLEE from the Mississippi river batture, refloat the vessel, and return the vessel to the New Orleans District by 12 Nov 05. The barge is located at approximately mile 101.5 AHP on the right descending bank. The New Orleans District wharf is located at mile 102.8 AHP on the left descending bank.

The crane barge is welded steel 195 feet long, 54 feet wide, and 10 feet deep, with a square stern and a raked bow. The drafts are approximately 4 foot 7 inches forward and 4 foot 3 inches aft. The end of the barge with the crane base is the stern. The displacement is approximately 1,440 short tons.

The barge is located approximately 100 feet from the water with the Carrollton gauge at 3 feet NGVD. The methods used to remove the barge shall include lifting with mobile cranes, lifting with floating derrick cranes, and skidding on timbers. Excavation at the site shall be limited to leveling the area between the barge and water. The area shall be clean of all debris and materials used at the worksite.

A pre-proposal sight visit is most strongly urged. Interested parties must submit proposed plans and pricing to the Contracting Officer prior to the closing date and time for this solicitation.

REQUIREMENTS

The work shall be performed in accordance with the USACE Safety Manual EM 385-1-1. Prior to the start of work, a safety plan must be submitted to and approved by USACE using forms 385-43, 358-43(1), and 385-43(2). The Safety manual and safety plan forms are on USACE NOD website at <http://www.intra.mvn.usace.army.mil/insight/sso.asp>.

All work is subject to the Service Contract Act and DOL Wage Determination 94-2233 (25). The selected contractor must provide SF 1444 to the USACE legal office to conform any job classifications that do not appear on the WD.

ADDENDA

As a result of the U.S. Department of Labor Memorandum dated 09 Sep 2005 and signed by Charles E. James Sr., the following addenda apply to clauses in this contract.

Addendum to FAR 52.222-26:

The following text is added at the end of the clause;

“Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the contractor will not be obligated to develop the affirmative action program, prepare the reports, or provide the notices usually required under the regulations implementing E.O. 11246, as amended.”

Addendum to FAR 52.222-35:

The following text is added at the end of the clause;

“Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the contractor will not be obligated to develop the affirmative action program, prepare the reports, or provide the notices usually required under the regulations implementing section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended..”

Addendum to FAR 52.222-36:

“Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the contractor will not be obligated to develop the affirmative action program, prepare the reports, or provide the notices usually required under the regulations implementing E.O. 11246, as amended.”

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the following FAR requirements will continue:

- Posting of the "Equal Opportunity is the Law" notice;
- Recordkeeping and record retention; and
- Employment listings with appropriate local employment service office.

PROPOSAL

Proposals shall include, at a minimum, a firm fixed price for the work, a work plan including the approach and methods to perform the work, and a firm detailed project schedule that includes dates for mobilization, schedule of work, completion of work, and demobilization. Contractor's should provide any other information that can assist USACE in determining technical acceptability. The schedule, especially the proposed completion date, will form part of the basis of the decision on technical acceptability.

AWARD

This is an urgent and compelling requirement. Award will be made to the lowest priced technically acceptable proposal. A technically acceptable proposal is one that provides for completion of work in a time period that is responsive to the urgent nature of the requirement and provides the approach, methods, capability, assets, planning and schedule that provides confidence to USACE that the work can be performed as needed.
