QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS 2

**QUESTION:** We are wondering if we can team with a NELAC lab, with us performing physical sampling and being the prime. We would still be able to document accreditation through a subcontracted laboratory?

**ANSWER:** The NELAC accreditation is necessary for the laboratory doing the sample testing. As stated in the "Government Procedures" section of the solicitation, "If a vendor wishes to have the sample testing subcontracted out to another business that has laboratory services, then the subcontractor will have to also be a small business. This is necessary because the lab testing and reporting comprise the larger part of the required work per Task." As long as the lab's NELAC accreditation is in your proposal, then that is acceptable.

**QUESTION:** It appears the New Orleans District Water Quality Laboratory will analyze for some of the parameters listed in Table 3 (i.e. ammonia, biochemical oxygen demand, Kjeldahl nitrogen, phosphorous, inorganic phosphorous, and solids). Can you confirm that the Corps will be responsible for these costs directly and that the inclusion of these costs into our bid is not necessary?

**ANSWER:** The inclusion of the costs for **all** parameters shown in Table 3 in the bid **is** necessary.

**QUESTION:** Is this a new project?

**ANSWER:** No it is not. This project has been awarded in the past under other contracts. The prior award was made under contract number W912P8-06-P-0026

**QUESTION:** Bidders list or list of persons or planholders list.

**ANSWER:** As far as I am aware, the current posting requirements for USACE to post to FedTeds does not have the capability of listing plan holders or bidders.

**QUESTION:** Person or entity currently performing the contract/project

**ANSWER:** Anacon, Inc.

**QUESTION:** Main differences between old statement of work and the current one

**ANSWER:** The last contract was for a one-month period. The new contract is an IDIQ contract with a base plus Two Option Years. The requirements are the same, but specific required tests may vary as Tasks are issued off of the contract.

**QUESTION:** Old contract amount and /price or contract budget

**ANSWER:** The old contract was awarded for \$16,685.00

**QUESTION:** Other question and answers from other contractors/persons

**ANSWER:** Other questions and answers for this solicitation have been posted in amendments to this solicitation.
