Delete the bidding schedule page 00010-3 in its entirety and replace with the revised attached bidding schedule page 00010-3.

SECTION 02482

1. Page 7, paragraph 3.1.2. Delete the second paragraph and replace with the revised paragraph:

“The Contractor shall note that the area shown as the borrow area, on the contract drawings, is also designated as a disposal area for hopper dredges. It is the Government’s intent, under this contract, to mine 4,000,000 cu. yds. of material from the borrow area to the bottom elevation of (-) 30.0 feet MLG and place it into the wetland creation area, as shown on the contract drawings. Circumstances may arise such that the Contractor may be required to coordinate this work with hopper dredges working in Southwest Pass of the Mississippi River. If such coordination is required, the Contractor may be directed to move dredging operations within the borrow area to an area which will cause the least impact to both dredging and hopper disposal operations. Also, due to unforeseen circumstances, (i.e., Mississippi River stages and hopper dredging requirements for Southwest Pass) the Contractor shall note that the Government may exercise all or part of Item No. 0004 Option – Dredging.”

2. Page 7, paragraph 3.1.3. Delete the existing paragraph in its entirety and replace with the revised paragraph:

“3.1.3 Order Of Work

The Contractor shall begin work on the east or channelward side of the temporary baseline as shown on Sheet No. C-02 in the borrow area and dredge in a north-south direction and clear this area of shoal material. Upon completion of work in this area, the Contractor shall move to the northern limits of the borrow area and begin dredging in an east-west direction, in the borrow area.”

Award will be made as a whole to one bidder.

NOTE 1: Bidders shall furnish unit prices for each item listed in the Schedule requiring a unit price. If the bidder fails to insert a unit price in the appropriate blank for required item(s), but does furnish an extended total, or an estimated amount for such item(s), the Government shall deem the unit price to be the quotient obtained by dividing the extended amount for that line item by the quantity. IF A BIDDER OMITTS BOTH THE UNIT PRICE AND THE EXTENDED TOTAL OR ESTIMATED AMOUNT FOR ANY ITEM, ITS BID SHALL BE DECLARED NON-RESPONSIVE AND THEREFORE INELIGIBLE FOR AWARD.

NOTE 2: Any bid may be rejected if the Contracting Officer determines in writing that it is unreasonable as to price. Unreasonableness of price includes not only total price of bid, but the price for individual line items as well. Any bid may be rejected if the prices for any line items or subline items are materially unbalanced (See FAR 14.404-2).

NOTE 3: Bidders shall use the Item No. 0003 unit price to compute Item No. 0004 total price.

NOTE 4: THE NOTICE TO PROCEED (NTP): The successful bidder is advised that performance and payment bonds shall be submitted in accordance with the time frame in block 12B of SF 1442 after Notice of Award. The NTP will be issued immediately after verification of acceptable performance and payment bonds. Within 24 hrs after issuance of the NTP, the Contractor shall initiate a meeting to discuss the submittal process with the Area or Resident Engineer or his authorized representative. Physical work cannot start until the Accident Prevention Program, Contractor Quality Control Plan, and other submittals which may be required, have been submitted and approved and all preliminary meetings called for under the contract, have been conducted.

NOTE 5: This provision applies to Bid item 0004. The Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. Evaluation of options will not obligate the government to exercise the options.
