1.2 Accident Prevention Program

Refer to the Contract Clause in Section 00700 – Contract Clauses, entitled Accident Prevention (FAR 52.236-13). Within 24 hours after receipt of Notice of Award of the contract, four copies of the Accident Prevention Program shall be submitted to the Contracting Officer or his/her authorized representative for review and acceptance. The Accident Prevention Plan must include a statement that describes the: Description, Magnitude, Major Scope of Work and Location/s. This Description, Magnitude, Major Scope of Work and Location/s information shall also be identified on the referenced LMN Form 385-43-R (Accident Prevention Program Administrative Plan). The program shall be submitted in the following format:

- (1) An executed LMN Form 385-7-R Aug 99, entitled “Accident Prevention Plan Checklist, Administrative Section” refer to Section 1 para.01.A.07 of EM 385-1-1.
- (2) An executed LMN Form 385-6-R Aug 99, entitled “Accident Prevention Program, Hazard Analysis”, refer to Figure 1-1 and Appendix A of EM 385-1-1.
- (3) An executed LMN Form 385-43-R Aug 99, entitled “Accident Prevention Program, Administrative Plan” refer to Section 1 para. 01.B of EM 385-1-1.
- (4) A copy of company policy statement of accident prevention and any other guidance statements normally provided new employees.
- (5) When marine plant and equipment are in use under a contract, the method of fuel oil transfer shall be included on LMN-385-10-R, Fuel Oil Transfer. (Refer to 33 CFR 156).

The Contractor shall not commence physical work at the site until the program has been accepted by the Contracting Officer or his/her authorized representative. The Contractor may submit its Activity Hazard Analysis only for the first phase of construction provided that it is accompanied by an outline of the remaining phases of construction. All remaining phases shall be submitted and accepted prior to the beginning of work in each phase. Also refer to Sections 1 and 19.A.06 of EM 385-1-1.

If the Contractor is a currently accepted participant in the Dredging Contractors of America (DCA)/United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Dredging Safety Management Program (DSMP), as determined by the DCA/USACE Joint Committee, and holds a current valid Certificate of Compliance for both the Contractor Program and the Dredge(s) to be used to perform the work required under this contract, the Contractor may, in lieu of the submission of an Accident Prevention Plan (APP),

- (1) make available for review, upon request, the Contractor’s current Safety Management System (SMS) documentation,
- (2) submit to the Contracting Officer the current valid Company Certificate of Compliance for its SMS,
- (3) submit the current dredge(s) Certificate of Compliance based on third party audit, and
- (4) submit for review and acceptance, site-specific addenda to the SMS as specified in the solicitation.
