## GENERAL

1. Throughout these Plans & Specifications, change the LIMITS OF DREDGING to: "3690+00 c/l (Mile (-)3.89) to 3895+00 c/l (Mile (-)7.77)".
2. Throughout these Plans & Specifications, change the LIMIT OF WORK to: "3690+00 c/l (Mile (-)3.89) to 3960+00 c/l (Mile (-)9.0)".
3. The x/y coordinates provided on drawing 2 for 3690+00 c/l remains unchanged.
4. Disregard the staff gage identified under "benchmarks and gages" on contract drawing 1.

## SF-1442

1. Block 11, change "150 calendar days" to read "120 calendar days".
2. Block 12B, change "7 days" to read "24 hours".

## SECTION 00010

Delete the bidding schedule page 00010-3 in its entirety and replace with the revised attached bidding schedule page 00010-3.

## SECTION 00700

Page 13, paragraph 52.211-10. In the third line, change "150 calendar days" to "120 calendar days".

## SECTION 01100

Page 01100-2, paragraph 2(b), delete 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence and replace with: "Within 24 hours after receipt of Notice of Award of the contract, four copies of the Accident Prevention Program shall be submitted to the Contracting Officer for review and acceptance."

## SECTION 02482

1. Page 02482-1, paragraph 1.2.1. Delete the second sentence in its entirety and insert the following:

"Soundings obtained from a 03 Aug 04 control survey were used to derive dredge quantities depicted on the bid schedule and are readily available for review at the Corps of Engineers, New Orleans District, within the Cost Engineering Branch. For the purpose of measurement, the Contractor shall utilize the staff gage attached to

Beacon/Light 23 at Approximate MRGO Mile 3. Gage zero(0) is MLG datum; post 83 epoch.”

2. Page 02482-12, paragraph 3.3.9. At the end of the paragraph, insert the following:

“Bidders should be aware that the Eagle 1 is currently working in the MRGO Bar Channel, between Approximate MRGO Mile (-)7.7 and Approximate Mile (-)9.0, and are disposing of material in the ODMDS, and the Contractor should coordinate its operations (dredging and disposal) so as not to interfere with the other Contractor.”

NOTE 1: Bidders shall furnish unit prices for each item listed in the Schedule requiring a unit price. If the bidder fails to insert a unit price in the appropriate blank for required item(s), but does furnish an extended total, or an estimated amount for such item(s), the Government shall deem the unit price to be the quotient obtained by dividing the extended amount for that line item by the quantity. IF THE A BIDDER OMITTS BOTH THE UNIT PRICE AND THE EXTENDED TOTAL OR ESTIMATED AMOUNT FOR ANY ITEM, ITS BID SHALL BE DECLARED NON-RESPONSIVE AND THEREFORE INELIGIBLE FOR AWARD.

NOTE 2: Any bid may be rejected if the Contracting Officer determines in writing that it is unreasonable as to price. Unreasonableness of price includes not only total price of bid, but the price for individual line items as well. Any bid may be rejected if the prices for any line items or sub-line items are materially unbalanced (See [FAR 14.404-2](#)).

NOTE 3: THE NOTICE TO PROCEED (NTP): The successful bidder is advised that performance and payment bonds shall be submitted in accordance with the time frame in block 12B of SF 1442 after Notice of Award. The NTP will be issued immediately after verification of acceptable performance and payment bonds. Within 24 hrs after issuance of the NTP, the Contractor shall initiate a meeting to discuss the submittal process with the Area or resident Engineer or his authorized representative. Physical work cannot start until the Accident Prevention Program, Contractor Quality Control Plan, and other submittals which may be required, have been submitted and approved and all preliminary meetings called for under the contract, have been conducted.

NOTE 4: EVALUATION OF OPTIONS (FAR 52.217-5 JUL 1990) The Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. Evaluation of Option(s) will not obligate the Government to exercise the option(s).
