Questions and Answers:

Q. Is this still a small business set aside?

A. Yes, this is a 100% small business set- aside. Reference SF 1449, Page 1 of 61, block 10.

Q. Can any of this material be recycled?

A. The landfill is responsible for disposal. However the debris is disposed in accordance with applicable federal, State, and local regulations, the landfill is required to submit documentation of the field activities, which includes the amount of material disposed. Reference page 2 of 61 (service to be furnished) and page 3 of 61 (deliverables).

Q. Has the EPA, State, etc. approved this material as non-hazardous?

A. We are aware that this material must be disposed of in a State of Louisiana Type I Landfill and required to be located in Southeast Louisiana. The landfill shall be responsible for unloading the barges and proper landfill disposal of the barge debris in accordance with applicable Federal, State, and local regulations. Reference page 2 of 61.

Q. Do we need to provide unloading and decontamination of barges?

A. The offeror is responsible for identifying all required equipment, labor, materials and supplies necessary to offload each of the barges and properly dispose of the debris in a licensed landfill in accordance with all federal, state, and local environmental regulations. Reference page 11 of 61. The barges do not have to be decontaminated.

Q. If we need to supply the unloading or barge and the loading of debris onto (Etc). Can a front-end loader be driven onto the barges or will we need a crane?

A. The offeror is responsible for identifying all required equipment, labor, materials and supplies necessary to offload each of the barges and properly dispose of the debris in a licensed landfill in accordance with all federal, state, and local environmental regulations. Reference page 11 of 61.

Q. If this waste is wet (it maybe dripping water) this may create a DOT problem. Is this material wet?

A. Reference page 2 of 61, the barge debris can be viewed at anytime. It is temporarily stored on seven river barges, currently located near Bayou Boeuff Lock in St. Mary Parish, Louisiana near Morgan City. The offeror is responsible for identifying all required equipment, labor, materials and supplies necessary to offload each of the barges and properly dispose of the debris in a licensed landfill in accordance with all federal, state, and local environmental regulations. Reference page 11 of 61.

Q. Are the barges with the debris accessible at their current location or must they be moved?

A. No they are not accessible at their current location. All fleeting and waterway transport shall be performed by the US Army Corps of Engineers-New Orleans District (USACE-NOD)-Operations Division using government owned /operated marine vessel. The government will be responsible for safe transport of the barges to an offloading point specified by the landfill. Reference page 2 of 61 (Government Furnished Resources).

Q. We are considering bidding the Barge Debris Disposal Landfill Solicitation. The solicitation states on page 3 of 61 that electronic pictures of the barges will be made available to the landfill. Could we receive those pictures as well?
