NOTES

* Evacuation ordered & allowances began 27 Aug 2005. Allowances and cannot exceed 180 days. **Can be terminated at any time.**

* Only designated military commanders can order an evacuation, civilian ordered evacuations do not apply.

NOTES

* Allowance is made up of two parts, evacuation pay which is equal to the employee's pay immediately prior to the evacuation being declared and a per diem allowance for the employee and their household dependents.

* Two conditions must be met to rate the allowance: Employee must be under evacuation orders **AND** their home must not be habitable.

* If evacuation pay is no longer authorized, Commander may authorize administrative leave for a reasonable amount of time on a case-by-case basis.

* **Not Habitable means you can not and do not live there.** Living in a home consider not habitable makes the home habitable.
