Official Project Name

Baton Rouge Park and Recreation Commission Bicycle/Pedestrian Corridor Spur Expansion

Location

The project is located on Perkins Road at Dalrymple Drive, Lakeshore Drive at Dalrymple Drive, and on May Street at Dalrymple Drive around the City Park Lake area in the City of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

Purpose

Design a 5-foot wide bicycle/pedestrian corridor on Dalrymple Drive at Perkins Road, Lakeshore Drive, and May Street (three spur connections) bicycle/pedestrian corridor around City Park Lake area in East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana.

Authority

Section 22 of the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 1974 provides authority for the Corps of Engineers to assist the states, local governments, and other non-Federal entities in the preparation of comprehensive plans for the development, utilization and conservation of water and related land resources. Section 208 of WRDA of 1992 amended the WRDA of 1974 to include federally recognized Native American Tribes as equivalent to a state.

Scope

The scope of the project is to collect the required data and provide design assistance in order for Baton Rouge Park and Recreation Commission to submit the required design package to Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD) for use in the TEA-21 Program.
