The Paralyzed Veterans of America donated four hunting blinds, which are safely positioned in strategic locations to provide optimal hunting opportunities. For safety reasons and also to provide a quality experience for the hunter this area is closed for all other activities during gun and muzzleloader hunts for deer.
