Qualification Requirements:

- ◆ Degree in Early Childhood Education or related field that included 24 semester hours in Early Childhood Education OR Combination of education and experience: At least 4 years of experience in Early Childhood Development or an equivalent combination of early childhood experience, college level education and training that provided professional early childhood knowledge.
- ◆ One year of specialized experience equivalent to the GS-09 grade level in the Federal service managing the operation of an early childhood program, to include: budget planning or facility operations, supervision or oversight of direct employees or contracted personnel, development or oversight of child care curriculum or child care development programs.
