Duties:

- *Utilize equipment to remove trees, stumps, and other heavy objects.
- *Perform rough grading; roughing in and clearing roadways, boat ramps, and similar areas.
- *Operate wheeled or tracked tractors to tow attachments and non-self-propelled equipment such as: gang-type mowers, brush cutters, wagons, etc.
