**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:** In order to be considered and register for the event, send an email to: CEMVN-Careers@ usace.army.mil, and attach your most recent resume, any license/certification documents, DD 214-member copy 4, Schedule A letter from your doctor, VA letter and/or most recent unofficial transcript(s). Please bring additional resume and certification copies with you the day of the event.

**EVALUATIONS:** Candidates will be evaluated in accordance with the qualification and eligibility requirements set forth by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) located at <a href="https://www.opm.gov/policy-data-oversight/classification-qualification-standards/#url=Group-Standards">https://www.opm.gov/policy-data-oversight/classification-qualification-standards/#url=Group-Standards</a>.

## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- All positions require the applicant to be a citizen of the United States.
- Male applicants born after December 31, 1959, are required to register for Selective Service prior to appointment.
- A trial or probationary period may be required.
- Some positions may require a valid driver's license.
- Some positions may require a security clearance to include fingerprinting
- Some positions may require temporary duty travel
- Some positions may require random drug testing.
- Some positions may require a physical examination.
- Some positions may require selectee to possess certifications/licenses prior to employment.
- Some positions may require a Defense Acquisition Certification within 2 years of appointment.
- The following MAY be paid or offered: relocation incentive, recruitment incentive, service credit for leave, and/or student loan repayment.
- Promotion progression to the target position is contingent upon satisfactory completion of training requirements and continuous satisfactory performance.
- Post-secondary student appointments are term in nature and have the potential to convert into a permanent appointment in the competitive service.
- Selectee must obtain a passing score on the appropriate Administrative Careers with America (ACWA) assessment prior to appointment or conversion, if applicable.

**LOCATION ACCESS:** You will enter through the Prytania St. gate, (the district is located on the levee where Prytania and Leake meet). Access to the New Orleans District is restricted and requires a valid driver's license. The vehicle operator and individuals age 18 and over must process and be ready to present the following documents: valid vehicle registration, current vehicle insurance, and a valid driver's license at the visitor control center to obtain a visitor pass.
