- * *Independently troubleshoot and locate problems, and remove, repair or replace, and reinstall various assemblies and components.*

Qualification Requirements:

- ◆ Ability to work as a Lock and Dam Equipment Mechanic without more than normal supervision. This is defined as the ability to perform the common duties of a maintenance worker (eg.. remove, clean, or replace components of water and sewage systems. Tune-up, service and make minor repairs to internal combustion engines, apply grease and other lubricates to machinery.)
