Dear Mr. Bradberry and Ms. Lee-Sheng:

You are hereby informed that all of the construction work for the entire Harahan Pump to the River Basin work, which is a functional portion of the Southeast Louisiana (SELA) Project in Jefferson Parish, Louisiana, has been completed. The fully completed Harahan Pump to the River Basin work was performed pursuant to multiple contracts, which include the following: Intake Basin (SELA 09a), Pump Station (SELA 09), Discharge Tubes (SELA 07), North Discharge Tubes (SELA 07a), South Discharge Tubes (SELA 07b), and Discharge Basin (SELA 07c). The Harahan Pump to the River Basin work was completed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) pursuant to Section 108 of the Energy and Water Development Appropriations Act of 1996, Public Law (PL) 104-46; Section 533 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1996, PL 104-303, as amended; and the 6th Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act (Chapter 3, Title III), PL 110-252.

The final joint agency inspections for the completion of the last remaining features in the SELA 07c construction contract for the Harahan Pump to the River Basin work were conducted on August 10 and August 13, 2018. No punch list items were developed during both final inspections. All contract work was performed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and meets the ten percent annual exceedance probability design criteria. agency inspections for all of the Harahan Pump to the River Basin completed construction contracts have been documented in previously issued Notices of Construction Completion (NCC) disseminated by USACE to the non-Federal sponsors (NFS).


The following enclosures are included with this comprehensive NCC for the Harahan Pump to the River Basin work:

Volumes 1 and 2 of the Interim Operation, Maintenance, Repair, Replacement, and Rehabilitation (OMRR&R) Manual for SELA Project work performed in Jefferson Parish, Louisiana, inclusive of all Appendices, Exhibits and Attachments, and the SELA 07c contract work Fact Sheet, which has been updated to reflect all completed work - Enclosure 1.
- b. The red line as-built contract drawings for the completed SELA 07c contract work. Please note the red line as-built contract drawings for all of the previously completed Harahan Pump to the River Basin construction contracts have been provided to the NFS in conjunction with the previously issued NCCs - Enclosure 2.
- c. Two final inspection attendance rosters for the August 10 and August 13, 2018 joint agency inspections conducted for the completion of the SELA 07c construction contract - Enclosure 3.

In accordance with the Project Partnership Agreement between the Department of the Army and the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority of Louisiana, for the Southeast Louisiana, Louisiana Project, Jefferson and Orleans Parishes dated January 16, 2009, the Project Cooperation Agreement between the Department of the Army and Jefferson Parish, Louisiana dated January 16, 1997, and Amendment No. 1 thereto between the Department of the Army and Jefferson Parish, Louisiana dated March 24, 2005, the NFS shall undertake the OMRR&R of this completed project feature of the SELA Project in Jefferson Parish. In this connection, maintenance is construed as keeping all completed works in working condition to serve the purpose for which they were designed. Section 1010 of PL 113-121 provides for an appeals process.
