Please reference within this package, the signed Notice of Construction Completion ("NCC") for the Gardere Canal Phase III and Murphy Canal Phase I, Jefferson Parish (West Bank) Project ("Project") (Contract No.: W912P8-10-D-0012). The NCC serves as notice to the Non-Federal Sponsors that this Project, located within the Jefferson Parish portion of the Southeast Louisiana ("SELA") Program, has been completed and that the operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, and rehabilitation obligations of the Non-Federal Sponsors for this Project and all Project features have now commenced. This completed Project has passed final inspection and the United States Army Corps of Engineers ("Corps") has determined that this Project, which is a functional portion of the new work of the SELA Program, meets the ten percent annual exceedance probability design criteria in accordance with the requirements of the January 16, 2009 Project Partnership Agreement ("PPA"). The completion of this Project also brings the JP-6 Polder to full completion.

As you are aware, at the request of the Non-Federal Sponsors, the Corps agreed to perform the installation of a loop-detector on Peters Road in the vicinity of the Boomtown Casino in Harvey, Louisiana as a relocation item on behalf of the Non-Federal Sponsors, with the full advance cost of this relocation work being paid by the Non-Federal Sponsors to the Corps in accordance with the terms of the PPA. The loop detector and related apparatus is **not** a Project feature, and therefore the incompleteness of this item of relocation work for the Non-Federal Sponsors does not impact or affect the issuance of the NCC by the Corps for this Project.

I assure you that the Corps' Contractor will continue to utilize and employ all required safety measures until this relocation work is complete, and that the location of this remaining work is maintained in a safe condition for the workers and the general public. We anticipate that the loop-detector relocation work will be completed on or before February 15, 2017. Upon completion of this work or if further delays in the completion of the loop detector work are encountered, the Corps will promptly provide written notification of the same to the Non-Federal Sponsors.

If there are any questions concerning the completion of the loop-detector relocation work that the Corps' Contractor is performing on behalf, and at the expense, of the Non-Federal Sponsors, please call Mr. Mark Wingate, Deputy District Engineer for Project Management, at (504) 862-2204.
