GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY
ATCHAFALAYA RIVER
SUBAQUEOUS STONE PLACEMENT


Beginning on or about 3 December 2018 and continuing until approximately 30 May 2019, a U.S. Government Contractor will be placing subaqueous stone on the Right Descending Bank (RDB) of the Atchafalaya River, at Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW) river mile 98.0.

The Contractor will work during daylight hours, 7 days per week. The plant will include work barges with spuds and anchors. There will be tender and survey boats in the vicinity of the work.

The M/V OSCAR WALTERS will monitor VHF-FM marine channels 13 and 16, and can be contacted at (318) 452-0116.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
