NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 18-105

CALCASIEU RIVER
MILE 15 TO MILE 36 (UPDATE)

Reference Navigation Bulletin No. 17-141, dated 22 December 2017, stating that the U.S. Government Contract Cutterhead Dredges DREDGE 32 and MIKE HOOKS will be working in the Calcasieu River from mile 15 to mile 36, including the A4 Turning Basin, until approximately 15 August 2018.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE DREDGING OPERATIONS HAVE BEEN EXTENDED UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 31 DECEMBER 2018.

The Dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and will give way to passing navigation.

There are numerous work and support vessels associated with this dredging operation, which includes various work barges.

The Dredge can be contacted on either VHF channel 13 or 16 for sailing instructions.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
