CALCASIEU RIVER MILE 7 TO MILE 13

Commencing on or about 27 September 2020 and continuing until approximately 10 October 2020, the U.S. Government Contract Hopper Dredge BAYPORT will be working in the Calcasieu River from approximately mile 7 to mile 13.

Dredged material will be sidecast approximately 100 ft. from the dredge.

The support vessel M/V JOHN M will also be working on-site.

The dredge will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and will give way to passing navigation.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.

The dredge can be contacted on VHF marine channel 13, 16, or 66 for sailing instructions.
