GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY
CALCASIEU LOCK (UPDATE)

Reference Navigation Notice 17-124, dated 28 November 2017, stating that continuing until further notice, mariners are advised not to tie off to nor allow their vessels to rest against the south chamber wall at Calcasieu Lock due to the wall being unstable, and vessels tying to it or exerting force on it could cause the chamber wall to fail.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT BEGINNING ON OR ABOUT 1 MAY 2018 AND CONTINUING UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 1 DECEMBER 2019, A U.S. GOVERNMENT CONTRACTOR WILL BEGIN DEMOLITION OF THE SOUTH CHAMBER GUIDEWALL AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW GUIDEWALL AT CALCASIEU LOCK. THE LOCK WILL BE CLOSED TO NAVIGATION, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 5:00 P.M., EACH DAY.
