NAVIGATION BULLETIN NO. 19-14

MISSISSIPPI RIVER
SUBAQUEOUS STONE PLACEMENT

Beginning on or about 18 February 2019 and continuing until approximately 6 May 2019, a U.S. Government Contractor will be placing subaqueous stone on the Right Descending Bank (RDB) of the Mississippi River at Mile 257.5.

The Contractor will work 7 days a week, during daylight hours, and the plant will include an anchor barge with dragline. An office barge and various material barges will be on-site, staged outside the channel.

The M/V SHERYL and M/V KACIE LUHR will monitor VHF-FM marine channels 13, 16, and 72.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake, pass as close to the Left Descending Bank (LDB) as possible, and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
