## Project Fact Sheet

### **Official Project Name**

PAS - City of East Baton Rouge/Parish of East Baton Rouge Dalrymple Drive and University Lake Bicycle/Pedestrian Corridor

### **Location**

The project is located on Dalrymple Drive from Broussard St. to West Lakeshore Drive (City Park Lake area) and on South Lakeshore Drive From West Lakeshore Drive to Stanford Road (University Lake area) in the City of Baton Rouge/Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

### **Purpose**

Design a 5-foot wide bicycle/pedestrian corridor on Dalrymple Drive around the University Lake, and a 15-foot wide bicycle/pedestrian corridor (or less as field conditions permit up to 15-foot wide) around City Park Lake area in the City of Baton Rouge/Parish of East Baton Rouge (EBR) Parish, Louisiana.

### **Authority**

Section 22 of the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 1974 provides authority for the Corps of Engineers to assist the states, local governments, and other non-Federal entities in the preparation of comprehensive plans for the development, utilization and conservation of water and related land resources. Section 208 of WRDA of 1992 amended the WRDA of 1974 to include federally recognized Native American Tribes as equivalent to a state.

### **Scope**

The scope of the project is to collect the required data and provide design assistance in order for City of Baton Rouge/Parish of East Baton Rouge to submit the required design package to Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD) for use in the TEA-21 Program.
